#### **Lunch Time Incidents**

Parents.

There has been an increase of incidents with students throwing food in the building, particularly during lunch time. We know that both you and us have taught them better. However, since it is becoming more frequent of an issue we are taking steps to mitigate this and help our students realize the importance of their personal responsibility for their own things as well as for their physical learning environment. As such we will proceed with the following response to throwing food in the school:

Effective immediately, any student throwing food will receive a referral, will call home to parents and will be suspended. This rule will stay in effect until such time that we feel the problem has subsided.

Please help us avoid having to use such strict enforcement longer than necessary by helping reinforce the appropriate behaviors. Our hope is that we don't have to suspend anyone, but at the same time we cannot tolerate this kind of behavior in our school.
