Math Kangaroo International Math Competition

The online registration for the Math Kangaroo International Exam 2020 will close on Sunday, December 15th. Parents interested in registering their students should fill out this <u>form</u> for each student by Wednesday, December 11th in order to qualify for the \$21 registration fee. After December 15th, registration can happen only if there is a spot availability and with a late registration fee of \$35 The Math Kangaroo exam will be administered at the Draper 2 campus on **Thursday, March 19th, 2020 between 3:30 - 4:45 P.M.** Mountain Time. Students from all grades 1-12 are eligible to participate. The exam duration is 75 mins and has 24 multiple-choice questions (Grade 1 - 4) and 30 multiple-choice questions (Grade 5 - 12) with no negative marking. Students with top 20 scores at each level (grade) nationwide are placed on the National Winners List and recognized by the Math Kangaroo Committee with a reward and an Award of Excellence. Participation in this exam is highly encouraged as it gives the students the look and feel and the taste of an international competition while fostering healthy competition at an early age.
