AMC 8 Test

APA would like to invite all interested 7th and 8th graders to participate in the American Mathematics Competition 8 (AMC 8) to be given immediately after school on **Tuesday, November 12, 2019**. The test is short (25 multiple choice problems with a 40 minute time limit) but quite challenging. The first 30 students to return permission slips and pay will be given the test.

Math Kangaroo International Math Competition

American Prep has been approved as a testing center for the Math Kangaroo International Exam in Mathematics. The Math Kangaroo exam will be administered at the Draper 2 campus on **Thursday, 19 March, 2020 between 3:30 - 4:45 PM** Mountain Time.

Students from all grades 1-12 are eligible to participate. The exam duration is 75 mins and has 24 multiple-choice questions (Grade 1 - 4) and 30 multiple-choice questions (Grade 5 - 12) with no negative marking. Students with top 20 scores at each level (grade) nationwide are placed on the National Winners List and recognized by the Math Kangaroo Committee with a reward and an Award of Excellence. Enrollment is now open with a registration fee of \$21 and will end on Dec, 15, 2019. If you are interested in registering your students, please fill out this <u>form</u> for each student and you will be contacted with the next steps.
