- Dates/Times: Thu, 24th from 4 PM 7 PM & Fri, 25th from 12:30 PM 4 PM
- Format: By appointment. These are NOT open house style conferences.
- Location: on campus or via Zoom*
- Conference times: 10 minutes each
- How to sign up: All through Skyward!
 - Please watch this 60 second video tutorial from Skyward on signing up for conferences (video)
 - *Zoom calls: If you would prefer to do a Zoom call please first sign up for a time slot through Skyward. Then email the following to the respective teacher:
 - Your name
 - Student's name & respective course
 - Day and time of your conference
 - request to do Zoom (the teacher will set up the Zoom)
- Mrs. Stewart and Mrs. Gow (Math) if your student has either of these teachers for math you will receive a separate email with a signupgenius link to schedule conferences for them (just them, you can still use the Skyward app to sign up for conferences with their other teachers).

12th Grade United Way Day

12th grade's United Way Day is happening on **Tuesday, September 29** during 4th period. United Way Day is a large annual service project that the seniors participate in. This year we are partnering with an organization called "Stitching Hearts," a humanitarian group that helps people who have been impacted by natural disasters, those without a home, and refugees. For our project, we will be making sleeping mats for families who lost their homes in the 2018 Paradise, California fire, and creating toys and games for children. Because Stitching Hearts is a non-profit group, they gather their supplies through donations. Here's what we need from students:

We invite all the 12th-grade students to bring \$2-\$3 so that the organization can replenish their supplies after the event. We want to have this before the event starts.

We also need plastic grocery bags! These need to be in good condition, with no holes or tears, since they will be used to put together sleeping mats.

American Prep Offers Free Meals to All Enrolled Students

Thanks to a USDA free meal waiver, American Preparatory Academy will begin offering lunch at no cost to all enrolled students who pre-order beginning Tuesday, September 15th at all school locations. All students are eligible, whether they are learning in the classroom, online or at home.

How to Order

All families are asked to follow our normal procedures for ordering lunch:

- 1. Complete an application https://www.americanprep.org/school-lunch-program/eligibility/ Regardless of your status, all lunches will be free.
- 2. Our school lunch staff will set up an account on our online ordering system.
- 3. Parents receive instructions to pre-order lunches one month at a time (currently through the end of September).

If you have already completed an application and would like to order free lunches, email lunch@apamail.org so we can set up an account for online ordering.

On Campus Students

Lunch is served to each elementary classroom, and in the Jr. High and High School cafeterias. All meals must be pre-ordered 48 hours in advance. Lunches are prepared off-site, and are not always available upon demand. All lunches are COLD sack lunches. Microwaves are available for secondary students.

Off Campus Students

Off Campus learners may pick up meals at specific times and locations as designated by each school. Additionally, these families may pick up meals for any siblings who are 18 years of age or younger. All meals must be pre-ordered 48 hours in advance.

USDA does not guarantee the length of this free meal waiver. They are committing to free meal service through December 31st, 2020 or until current funding runs out. Due to the potential expiration of this waiver, we are encouraging parents to continue applying for free and reduced meal eligibility so that they won't experience a lapse in benefits.
