Emergency Broadband Benefit

The Emergency Broadband Benefit (EBB) program is a Federal Communication Commission program that helps households struggling to pay for internet service during the coronavirus pandemic. Eligible households can receive a discount:

- Up to \$50/month towards broadband service including unlimited data plans.
- Up to \$75/month for tribal households.
- Up to \$100/one-time to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers
 if the household contributes \$10 to \$50 toward the purchase price.
