Ordering Lunches for March Through the End of the School Year

You may order lunches for March through the end of the school year starting now. All lunches must be ordered at least one week in advance. If you would like your child to have a school lunch on Tuesday, March 1st you MUST order by Tuesday, February 22nd, 2022. If you have not ordered, please send a lunch with your child. We have some items on hand for emergencies, but often that is just milk, fruit, and vegetables.

How To Order

Please follow these instructions to place your order

- Go to https://apalunch.h1.hotlunchonline.net/
- Login with your email and password.
 - If you forgot your password, try 1234.
 - o If you need to answer a security question, what is library card # try 1234.
- Click on ORDER (top middle).
- Top right make sure to move arrow to March
- Add menu items (quantity 1) to the cart by clicking on the Blue bar (Regular or Vegetarian) to add to cart.
- Review and place the order.
- DO YOU HAVE MORE THAN ONE STUDENT? Be sure to use the drop-down button at the top to navigate to the next student and repeat the ordering process.
- DO YOU WANT TO ORDER THRU END OF YEAR? Be sure to click on arrow on top right to go to the next month (April, May)

Ordering Milk Only (To have with home lunch)

For your convenience, milk is available to order a la carte. We are experiencing disruptions in our milk supply at our Draper campuses. We are not able to offer refunds for milk ordered a la carte that are not delivered due to supply chain problems.

Why We Pre-Order Lunches

All meals are prepared at our central kitchen, cooled, and delivered to the campuses, where they are stored in refrigerators. In order to estimate meal production and facilitate delivery to elementary classrooms, we ask parents to pre-order meals.
