This is a really great opportunity for parents and others to be in the school and to make a BIG difference! Being an elementary substitute is REALLY FUN! ## Go Girlz Program at the U of U

The University of Utah invites young girls to participate in its year-long [Go Girlz program!](#) Powered by the Women's Resource Center on campus, it's free and open to all girls and femme-identified students in grades 6-12. The program strives to build a learning community of students with diverse cultural, racial/ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds in order to co-create the possibility of higher education for all girls and femme-identified people.

Go Girlz focuses on topics like body image, self-love, communication, gender roles, academic achievement, etc. to help young people step forward and achieve their goals. In addition to the workshops offered, the program provides access services to help young folks get on the right track to attend higher education institutions, such as ACT prep/retakes, college admission assistance and personal statement sessions. Our workshops begin the week of September 10, come check us out!
