Ordering Lunches for January

You may order lunches for January starting December 6th. All lunches must be ordered at least one week in advance. If you would like your child to have a school lunch on Monday, January 3rd you MUST order by Monday, December 27th, 2021. If you have not ordered, please send a lunch with your child. We have some items on hand for emergencies, but often that is just milk, fruit, and vegetables.

- Go to <https://apalunch.h1.hotlunchonline.net/>
- Login with your email and password.
 - ○ If you forgot your password, try 1234.
 - ○ If you need to answer a security question, what is library card # try 1234.
- Click on ORDER (top middle).
- Top right make sure to move arrow to January
- Add menu items (quantity 1) to the cart by clicking on the Blue bar (Regular or Vegetarian) to add to cart.
- Review and place the order.
- DO YOU HAVE MORE THAN ONE STUDENT? Be sure to use the drop-down button at the top to navigate to the next student and repeat the ordering process.

New Student Enrollment

We have begun the 2022-2023 NEW STUDENT enrollment process! We are now accepting applications for new siblings (including kindergarten students) and transfers. Please remember that new kindergarten students must be 5 on or before September 1st to qualify for enrollment; there are no exceptions to this rule. Lotteries will begin on January 3rd, so make sure you have completed the application prior to then to increase the likelihood of receiving your priority enrollment status. Please visit www.americanprep.org/enrollment to complete the application.

You may need one of the following enrollment codes:

- For sibling enrollment: sibling2022
- For transfer enrollment (if you want to transfer your student to another APA campus): transfer2022
- For Covid-related re-enrollment (new this year, if you or someone you know withdrew from enrollment at APA due to covid-related concerns, you can apply for enrollment using this code): covid2022
- No code is needed for families new to APA.
