Attendance School

Attendance School is scheduled on Wednesdays and Saturdays towards the end of each term. As these dates become available, they will be posted on our Draper 3 website calendar, included in our weekly newsletter and our morning announcements.

How do I know if I have Attendance School? Login to Skyward to see if you have an "NC" grade for any of your classes. Check your attendance to see how many tardies you have for the term. You are given 3 "freebies" per class/per term (4 or more tardies count towards Attendance School). If you have 5 tardies, deduct 3 which leaves you with 2 tardies. This means \$10 and 1 hr.

Now what do I need to know?

- Each tardy is \$5/30 minutes
- o No payment will be accepted on the day of Attendance School.
- o You must be PRE registered* AND be PREpaid** by NOON the day before (Tue/Fri).
- * to PRE-register: Go to our Draper 3 website Parent Resources Attendance School Form (last option). Fill out the form for the date you plan to attend (please don't click every date, just one ONE you plan to attend and pay for).
- ** to PRE pay: log in to parent Skyward account, click on Fee Management, Optional Fee (you must create an Efunds acct if you haven't already), click student name then click Attendance School. Click on amounts equal to the total you are paying for.
- OR payments can be made at the front office up to 12:00 NOON the day before. Cash or Credit Card is accepted.
- Please arrive 15-20 mins early to check in (6:40 am on Saturday, 2:10pm on Wednesday) to allow time to go to your locker/bathroom to get everything you need before checking in.
- Attendance School starts promptly at 7:00am/2:30pm. Students who arrive late (at start time or later) will be asked to pre register and attend the next available Attendance School date.
- No food or electronics will be allowed. A bottle of water is acceptable.
- o Arrive Prepared!! Students can 1. work on homework or 2. read a book. You can not go to your locker after you have checked in so make sure you have everything you need!
- o Must be in FULL Monday-Thursday uniform, including name tag.
- NC will not be removed until hours and fee have been paid
- o Students not following rules will be asked to leave, call home and pre register for the next



available Attendance School date. No credit will be given.

Is Attendance School every Wednesday and Saturday?

No. Multiple Attendance School dates are scheduled towards the end of each term. Look in our Newsletters, on our website and on the bulletin boards located by the HS/JH Front Office for these dates.
